Simojärvi Boat Safari



The Boat Safari takes you to the largest lake in Ranua, covering roughly 90 square kilometers. As the saying goes: "There's a hundred islands and a thousand names in lake Simojärvi." There are trout, zander, perch, pike, whitefish, vendace and ide, among other species of fish in lake Simojärvi.

The Boat Safari starts at the Simojärvi boat dock. Explore the pristine and unspoiled wilderness. There will be campfire coffee by an open fire during the safari. In the fishing show, you'll get to see how people fish by trolling and fish traps on lake Simojärvi. With luck, you can see the dance of the northern lights in September. We welcome you to the Boat Safari!

When: May through October

Weekdays: Monday to Friday from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., or evenings from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Weekends: Saturday and Sunday from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Where: Simojärvi, Ranua, Simontaipale boat dock (30 min. drive from the center)

Group size: Minimum 4 persons Maximum 8 persons

Duration: 4 hours

Includes: Guides, coffee break, boat safari and transportation from Ranua Zoo to Simontaipale boat dock and back

Guides: 2, Skipper + deckhand

Equipment: Life vests for the customers. Customers should wear weather-appropriate clothing.
